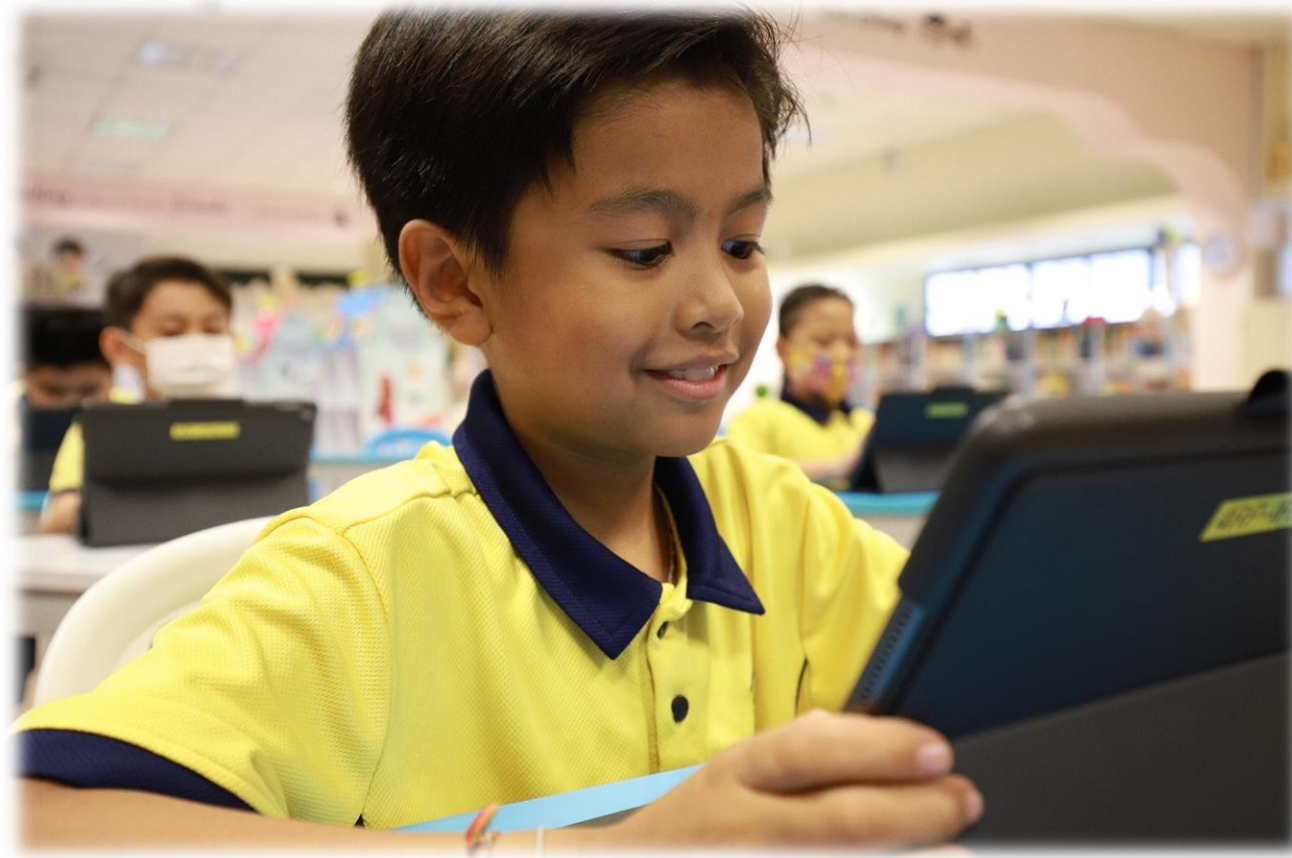

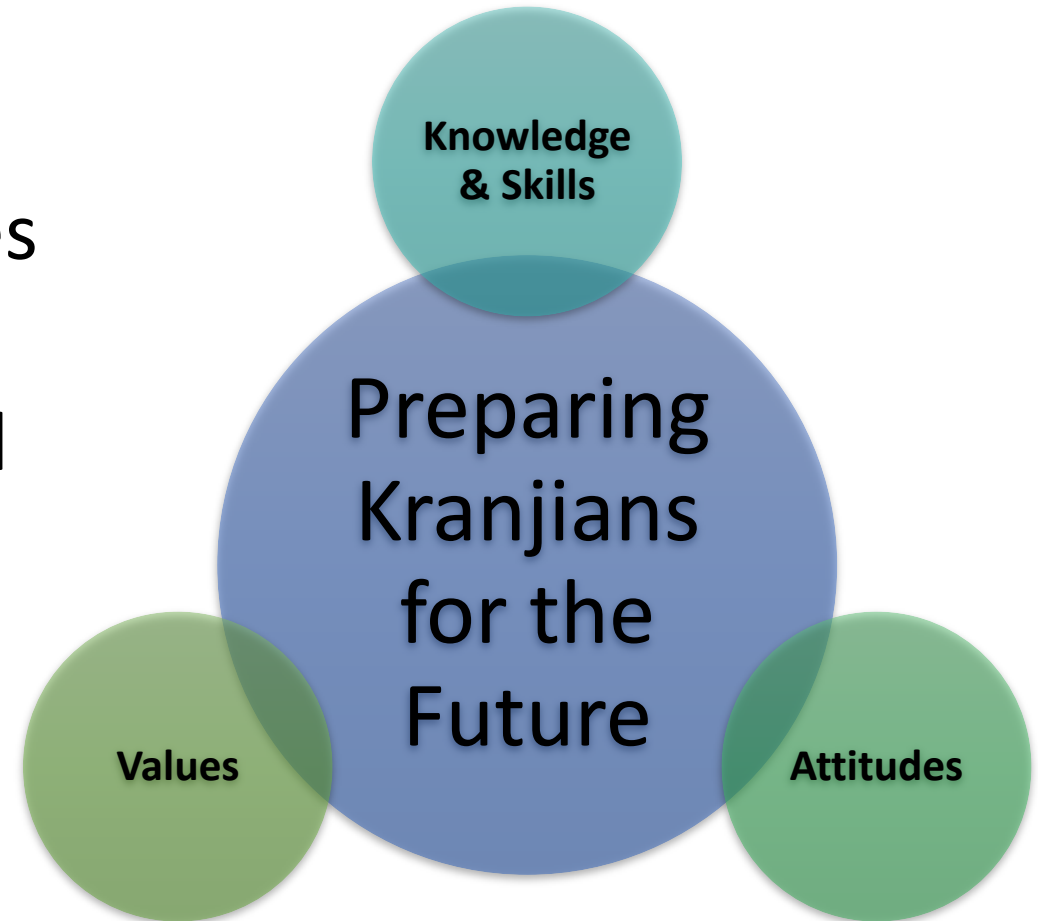

What is the 1:1 Learning Experience?

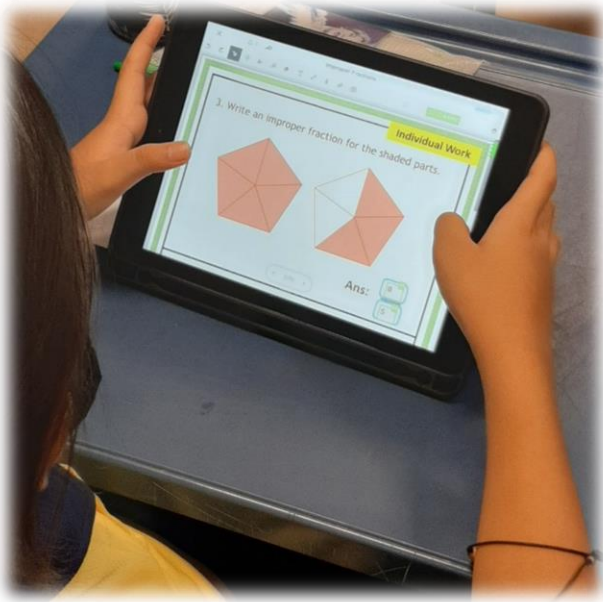
1:1 refers to one device for every student, where students will access learning through the device, both in and out of the classroom.

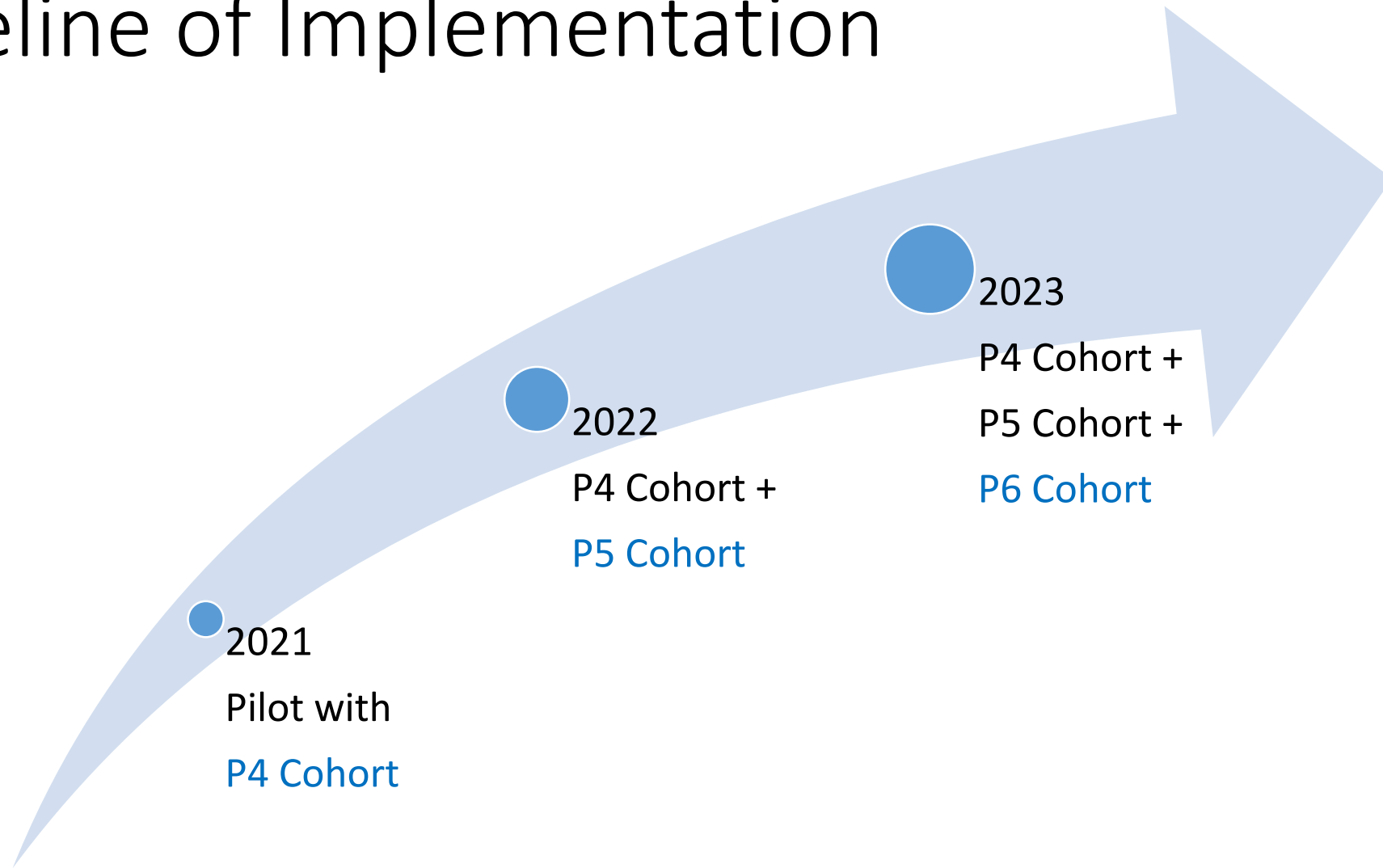

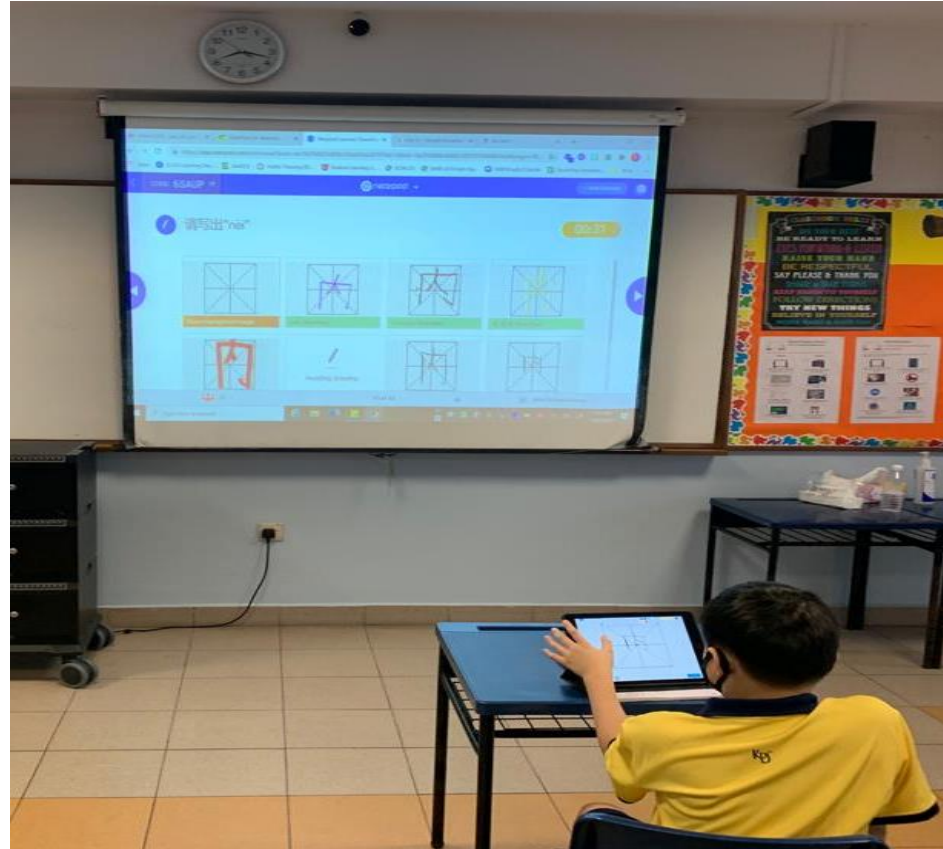

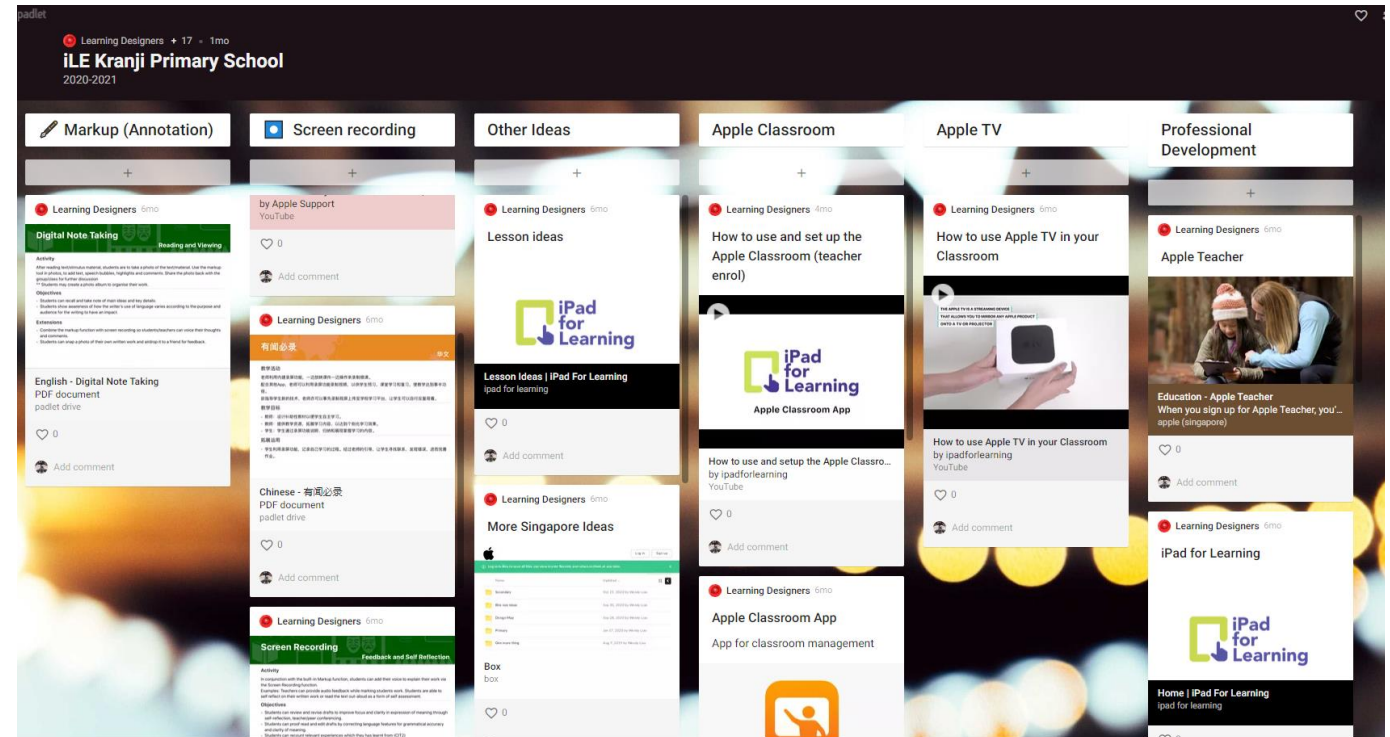

KPS iPad Rules

In the classroom & around the school

How we feel about iPads:
iPads are great tools for learning **when used properly**. To make sure that we use our iPads **effectively** we need to ensure that:

 We are to use 2 hands to hold the iPad at all times, when it is not on the table.	 When someone is talking, we close the lid of our iPad and place it on the table, so we can give our full attention.
 We never leave our iPads unattended. (e.g. leaving it under your desk)	 We never have any liquids or foods around our iPads.
 We only surf the internet and use the applications as instructed by our teachers.	 We always work at a table and never leave our iPads on the floor.
 We are gentle with our iPads and will never slam them or be rough with them.	 We only use the iPad that we are given and never touch or interfere with another student's iPad (AirDrop, etc).

Failure to follow these rules means that you are breaking our school's ICT Policy and may have your access to technology limited and be subjected to disciplinary action by the school.

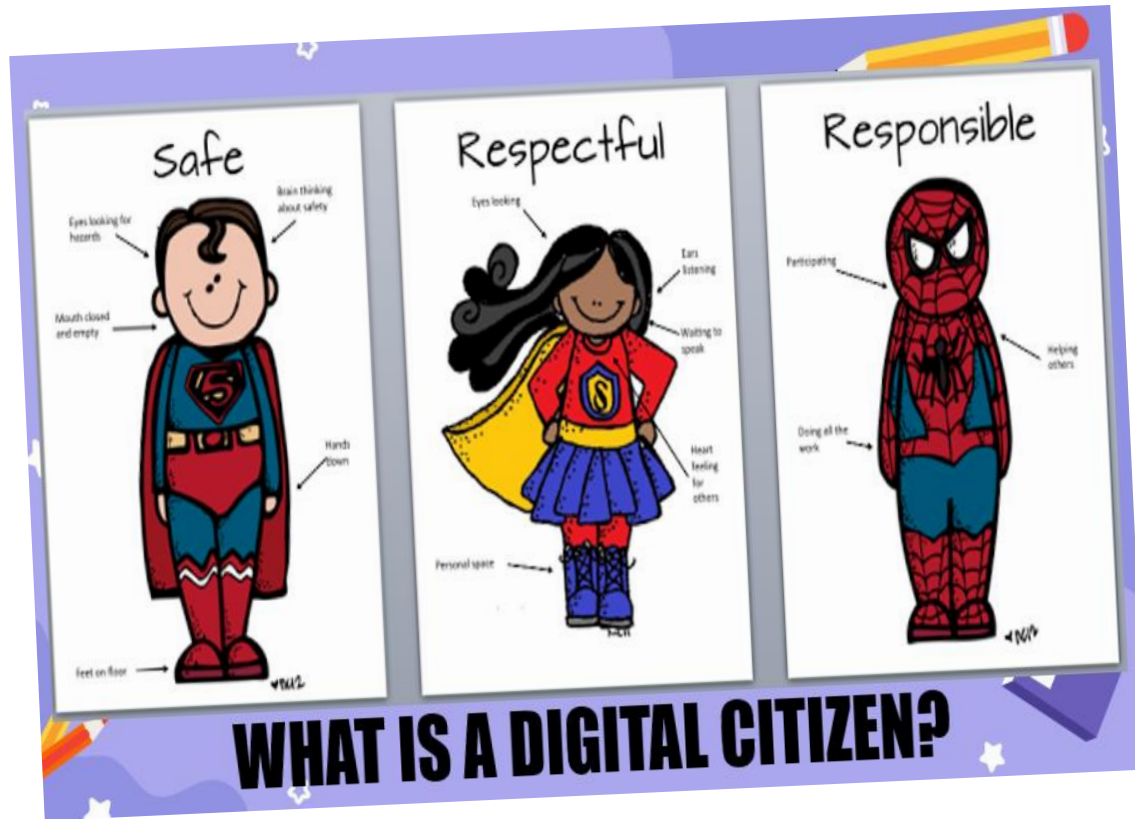

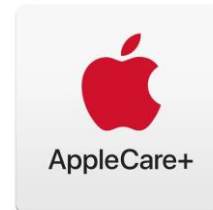

Assistance Available

- All P4 students will continue to be provided with an iPad by the school during curriculum hours if they are unable to bring one from home.
- Do note that students **are not allowed** to bring home these school-owned devices.
- Children on financial assistance can tap on NeuPC to purchase a device for home (although iPad is not an option)



Can students bring other types of devices to school?

- To better manage teaching and learning when in school, as well as for software and device compatibility reasons, **the school would only accept the iPad as the learning device to be brought to school for now.**

- Ensure that your child is only accessing age-appropriate apps and content in Safari

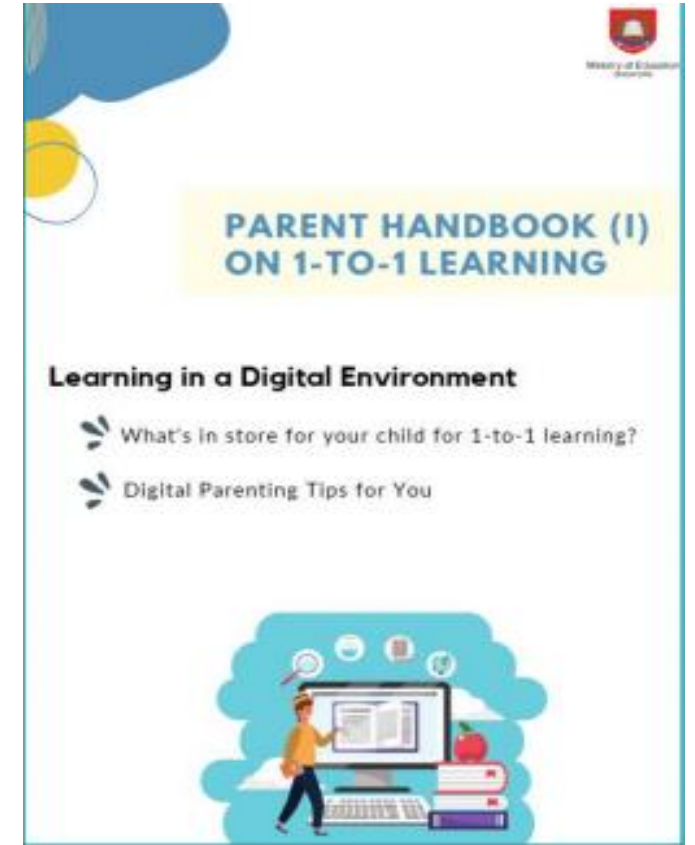
