Total Defence Day 2023 Together We Keep Singapore Strong

Total Defence Day (TDD) is observed annually on February 15, the day that Singapore surrendered to Japan in 1942, during World War II.

These include misinformation, supply chain disruptions, and food security, which affect communities and Singapore's way of life. Everyone has a part to play in our daily lives to ensure that Singapore is prepared for crises and disruptions and that we remain resilient and united as one people.

Kranji Primary School will commemorate TDD on Monday, 13 February 2023. The theme for TDD 2023 is 'Together We Keep Singapore Strong' with a focus on Food Security, one of the six pillars of Singapore's Total Defence. The assembly talk will create awareness of the increasing food wastage in Singapore. To supplement the assembly, every form teacher will devote 1 hour in week 7 to reinforce the TDD message during CCE (FTGP) lesson on Wednesday, 15 February 2023.

School Health Visit for Primary 1 to 6 Students

Please note that immunisation will only be administered to your child if required. No further action is needed if this has been previously submitted or there is no update.

P1 and P5 students are to submit their health booklets together with their immunisation certificates through their form teachers by Monday, 6 February 2023.

Photo-Taking Session for School Smart Card (SSC)

MOE will be conducting the yearly photo-taking exercise for all students in Primary One (P1) and Primary Six (P6) for the issue of the SSC.
