Self-Testing for P1-P5 Students


We refer to MOE's announcements to all parents posted on Parents Gateway on 24 Sep 2021 and 7 Oct 2021, and our letter to parents on 7 Oct 2021.

Parents of P1 - P5 students should conduct an Antigen Rapid Test (ART) with your child(ren) at home on either 8 or 9 October to ensure the safe return of students to school. Please submit your child's ART results via the FormSG link https://www.go.gov.sg/artresult-pri.

If your child tests positive, please head to the nearest Swab and Send Home (SASH) Public Health Preparedness Clinic (PHPC) for a Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test and inform the school immediately. Please visit https://flu.gowhere.gov.sg to locate the nearest SASH PHPC that provides PCR tests for children aged 13 and below. As a good practice, do take a photograph of the ART result with your child's identity card (e.g. MOE-issued EZ-Link Card) to show the clinic.

We would like to thank parents for the vigilance, care and concern, and remind all parents to continue exercising social responsibility.

Early Dismissal for Selected Students on eve of Deepavali



This year, Deepavali falls on Thursday, 4 November 2021. All students celebrating Deepavali may be dismissed at 10.30 am on the eve of Deepavali, Wednesday, 3 November 2021 if the consent is received from the parent.

If you wish to let your child/ward be dismissed early at 10.30 am on 3 November 2021, please submit your consent by completing the form via this link https://form.gov.sg/615fed82d1067600127aebe6 or QR code below by Thursday, 28 October 2021. If no consent for early dismissal is received for your child/ward, he/she will be dismissed at 1.30 pm on 3 November 2021 as per normal.

If your child/ward is taking school bus service, please make your own transport arrangement on 3 November 2021 if you had opted for early dismissal for your child/ ward, as there will be no school bus service at that timing.

Application for MOE-Financial Assistance Scheme (MOE-FAS) for Year 2022

The objective of the MOE-Financial Assistance Scheme (MOE-FAS) is to help financially needy Singaporean students in Government and Government-aided schools to meet basic school expenses. The application for MOE-FAS for Year 2022 is now open. Students who are currently under the Financial Assistance would **not** be automatically considered unless a **fresh** application is submitted.

If you wish to apply for financial assistance for your child/children for Year 2022, please complete the enclosed application form and submit it with the supporting documents to the **School General Office** latest by <u>Friday</u>, <u>15 October 2021</u> through your child/ward when they return to the school. Please ensure the envelope is <u>sealed</u> and addressed to our School's General Office (Attention: Admin Manager). You may also wish to alert your child's/ward's Form Teachers on the submission so that they could help to retrieve the envelope from your child/ward.

Alternatively, you may email the <u>signed</u> application form together with the supporting documents to **kranji_ps@moe.edu.sg** for our processing. We may require the original application forms to be submitted to our school and will contact you to arrange the submission at a later date, if need be. Due to the COVID-19 situation, please note that parents are not allowed to enter the school without any prior appointment.

We have enclosed the MOE-FAS pamphlet on the income eligibility and benefits for your information. Please note the other terms and conditions for MOE-FAS as follows:

- a. Only Singaporean students are eligible for the financial assistance under MOE-FAS.
- b. Submit the documents listed in paragraph 11 of the MOE-FAS application form, as applicable.
- **c.** By submitting the MOE FAS Application Form, you (parent or legal guardian) are giving the authorization to the school for the use of your child's/ward's Edusave account to pay for the 2nd tier miscellaneous fees and the cost of both local and overseas enrichment programmes. Please refer to Paragraph 2 of Section VI of the form for details.
- d. Parents/Guardians with more than 1 child studying in the same or different Government or Government-aided schools need to complete and submit only ONE application for all the school-going children to the school of ANY child. The details of all the children in your household who are applying for the financial assistance under the MOE-FAS should be clearly stated in the table under Section I of the application form.
- e. If you had applied for MOE-FAS through another school of your child's sibling, please submit the approval letter to our school **as soon as it is received from the sibling's school**. This is to facilitate prompt issuance of the free textbooks and uniforms to your child in our school.
- f. Application forms are to be duly completed, **signed** and submitted together with copies of **all** relevant documents. Failing to submit the application by the deadline or incomplete application will result in delay in processing your application.
