Chinese New Year Celebration



The school will be celebrating Chinese New Year on 11 February 2021, Thursday from 7.30 a.m to 9.30 a.m.

Students are strongly encouraged to come dressed in Chinese ethnic costumes with school shoes and socks (no headgear) for the day, or their usual school uniform.

The celebration will last for 2 hours. The first hour of the celebration focuses on the tradition of Chinese New Year. Art & craft activities related to Chinese New Year will be carried out. Students will also spring clean and decorate their classrooms. The second half of the celebration, which is an online concert, will start at 8.30 am and end by 9.30 am. Students will watch the performance and take part in quizzes to win prizes.

We would like to invite all parents to join us for the online concert from 8.30 am to 9.30 am. We are sure that your presence will add to the festivities as we celebrate the occasion together as one big family.


To kickstart the commemoration, we will listen to the Total Defence Day (TDD) Message from the Defence Minister and the rationale for schools to commemorate TDD.

Sports and Outdoor Adventure Camp

The **Sports and Outdoor Adventure Camp** is a key element of our Learning for Life Programme (LLP): Developing Champions in Life through Sports. We will be conducting a 2-day and 3-day camp for Primary 4 and Primary 5 levels respectively.



P4 Sports and Outdoor Adventure Camp

The P4 Sports and Outdoor Adventure Camp will be held at Kranji Primary School for all Primary 4 students on Thursday and Friday, 4 and 5 March 2021 during curriculum hours from 7.30 a.m. to 1.30 p.m. daily. More details will be provided at a later date.

P5 Sports and Outdoor Adventure Camp

The P5 Sports and Outdoor Adventure Camp will be held at Kranji Primary School and MOE Dairy Farm Outdoor Adventure Learning Centre. This is a 3-day non-residential camp. It will be conducted for all Primary 5 students from Thursday to Saturday, 11 to 13 March 2021 from 7.15 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. daily. MOE Kindergarten (MK) @ Kranji Registration for 2022 K1

Online registration for 2022 K1 admission has opened from <u>9am on Friday</u>, <u>5 February 2021 to 4pm on Tuesday</u>, <u>9 February 2021</u> and is open to Singapore Citizen and Singapore Permanent Resident children born between <u>2 January 2017</u> and <u>1 January 2018</u>, both dates inclusive.

School Bill 2021

We will be issuing a letter to parents in February providing a list of enrichment programmes for Year 2021 that require the students' copayment.

If you choose to opt for your child/ ward to participate in any of the enrichment programmes, a **School Bill** will be issued to you at a later date to make payment.

School Bill is a consolidated statement issued by school to inform you of your child/ward's enrichment programmes and school charges. This is separate from your payment of school fees to

MOE (MOE Bill).

Parents are strongly encouraged to pay the School Bill via GIRO, Edusave (for Singapore Citizen students only) or AXS (if you are not on GIRO).

Parents/students who wish to pay by cash/cheque can do so at the School's General Office (GO) only. Due to the safe management measures during the COVID-19 situation, parents are required to call the GO to make an appointment prior to your visit to school.

Please note that with the School Bill, teachers will <u>no</u> longer be collecting any payment from the students.

Staying Safe During the Chinese New Year Period

During the festive season, there is a higher risk of transmission as interactions in the community increase.

With Chinese New Year approaching, please remind your child/ward to continue to practise good personal hygiene (e.g. wash hands before eating), and be socially responsible (e.g. wear a mask).

Students are also reminded to cooperate with, and comply with the instructions of enforcement officers



(EOs), and SG Clean and Safe Distancing Ambassadors.

We would also like to remind parents that if your child is unwell, please seek immediate medical attention and ensure that your child has recovered fully before returning to school.
