## **Information on School Reopening in 2021**

A very warm welcome back to Kranji Primary School!

- 2. With 2020 coming to an end in about 1 weeks' time, my colleagues and I have been busy putting the finishing touches on our plans to welcome our students back to school next week. In preparation for the start of school, we would like to inform you of the following to ensure a smooth start to the new year:
  - a. Arrangements for First Day of School (5 January 2021)
    As announced by the Ministry of Education (MOE) on Friday, 18 December 2020, P2 to P6 students will <u>report to school on Tuesday, 5 January 2021</u>. School hours for 2021 remain unchanged for Mondays to Fridays from 7.30 am to 1.30 pm.
  - b. Students Requiring Care Arrangements on 4 January 2021
    - For students who require care arrangements on the morning of Monday, 4 January 2021, parents are requested to submit your request through the following link (<a href="https://go.gov.sg/kps-request-form-4jan21">https://go.gov.sg/kps-request-form-4jan21</a>) or QR code by <a href="mailto:9am on Thursday">9am on Thursday</a>, 31
       December 2020
       The school will follow up with more details once we receive your submission.



- ii. School hours for P2 to P6 students reporting to school on Monday, 4 January 2021, will be from 7.30 am to 12.00 pm. If you require school bus services that day, please liaise with the School Bus Service Provider directly.
- iii. Our school-based Student Care Centre (SCC) operated by NASCANS will be open in the afternoon on Monday, 4 January 2021. P2 to P6 students who are in school in the morning and are current enrolled students in the SCC, will proceed to the SCC at 12.00 pm. For P2 to P6 students enrolled in the SCC who wish to attend SCC in the afternoon of Monday 4 January 2021, the reporting time is 1.30 pm. Please inform NASCANS directly if you would like to send your child to the SCC in the afternoon.
- 3. The school will ensure that Safe Management Measures (SMM) are in place to keep our students safe. This includes the following:
  - a. Students and staff who are unwell, or who have adult household members on home quarantine / Stay Home Notice or have flu-like symptoms such as fever and cough, will be required to stay away from school. Please inform your child's Form Teachers or the school's General Office if any of the above is applicable to your child.

- b. Students should bring along their Oral Digital Thermometers (ODT) to school on a daily basis together with their face shields. Students who need to purchase a replacement ODT or face shield can do so at the school bookshop when school starts.
- c. Students and staff are required to wear their masks or face shields at all times when they are in school.
- d. High-touch surfaces are cleaned more frequently in school and the premises disinfected daily.
- e. Students will practise frequent hand-washing throughout the school day and practise wipedown of tables and shared equipment after use.
- f. Recess and dismissal timings will be staggered to reduce congestion, in line with the national posture on Covid-19. Please be assured that all effort is taken to ensure that students have enough time to consume their food during recess.

- 4. Please note that it is not mandatory for students to have a TraceTogether token when school reopens. It will be required in school only when all of the tokens have been distributed nationwide.
- 5. Most Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) and school activities will resume, higher-risk activities will remain suspended or limited to a smaller group. More information will be provided in the January Letter to Parents.
