Covid-19 Matters

In line with the national easing of community Safe Management Measures, the school will make the necessary adjustments following closely MOE guidelines. This includes the return to the School Hall for the conduct of Flag Raising Ceremony and Assembly, resumption of recess activities (including ActivePlay@Recess, MakerSpace activities and English Reading Train activities), and mask-off provision for specific groups of teachers and students during language and literacy lessons.

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P4 & P6 Mid-Year Examination

P4 & P6 Mid-Year Oral Examination

The Mid-Year Oral Examination will commence in April. The details are given below. Students are requested to report to the School Canteen punctually. P4 students will be dismissed upon completion of both the English Language and Mother Tongue (MT) Oral Examination, except for students who are exempted from MT. P6 students will be dismissed once they have completed the oral examination for the day. Please make the necessary transport arrangement/s for your child/ward.

Please note that there will be no make-up for the Oral Examination. A medical certificate or a valid reason such as being within 7 days of being tested PCR+ or ART+ is required for absence from the Oral Examination. This would also be applicable to the rest of the P4 & P6 Mid-Year Examinations. Please check with your child's teachers or the school's General Office if you require clarification. Your cooperation and support is much appreciated.

All P4 students will be taking the English Language and Mother Tongue Oral Examination on the same day after curriculum hours in Week 5.
