Keeping Kranjians Safe

As Singapore transits towards the endemic stage, right siting care towards primary care and self-responsibility will become the new default mode of recovery. With effect from 21 Jan 2022, the following will apply to Individuals on Protocol 1 and are in Community Treatment Facilities (CTF) or on Home Recovery Programme (HRP), or individuals on Protocol 2 (Primary Care):

- To self-isolate for 72 hours (no Isolation Order would be issued); and
- They may <u>self-exit</u> via negative self-administered ART after 72hr or until time-based discharged at 12pm on <u>D7</u> (fully vaccinated and children <12 years) or D14 (unvaccinated/partially vaccinated aged ≥12 years), whichever is earlier. D1 is taken to be the day of receipt of positive healthcare administered PCR/ART test results.</p>

Please note that our school would need to have sight of the ART test results for returning students who self-exit after 72 hours and before their time-based discharge. For other cases (e.g. students on HRW or those on time-based discharge for Protocol 2), students are not required to produce their test results before returning to school unless requested by the school.

We seek parents' cooperation on the following:

- a. If your child is unwell, please bring him/her to see a doctor and do not come to school. If he/she is tested positive and unwell, we would appreciate that parents keep the school updated on your child's well-being, as well as any changes to his/her health condition during the isolation period.
- b. If your child is well but self-tested positive, please adhere to the healthcare Protocol 2 and do not come to school.

Student COVID-19 Vaccination

We are pleased to note that an encouraging number of our students had booked their appointment for vaccination with many of them having received their 1st dose. We would like to encourage parents/guardians who have not yet signed up for a vaccination slot, to do so as soon as possible to protect your child/ward and family. A high vaccination rate will enable us to resume more activities that are important for our students' all-round development and eventual return to a rich school life.



Parents can make vaccination appointments for your child through the unique booking link that was sent to you earlier. If you did not receive the booking link or encounter issues with the link, you can register your interest on the MOH National Appointment System (NAS) at https://child.vaccine.gov.sg. With effect from 25 Jan 2022, these children will also be able to walk in with their parents or guardians to any paediatric vaccination centre to receive their first Covid-19 vaccination without the need for a prior appointment. This arrangement will be available from Mon to Thu before 7pm, and Tues to Thu before 5pm for the vaccination centre at Yusof Ishak Secondary School.

Parents are requested to remind your child to inform his/her teachers about the date of their vaccination/booster so that they will be exempted from strenuous physical activities for 2 weeks. Parents are also required to submit the vaccination appointment dates to the school via this link https://go.gov.sg/kpsvaccine.

The key message for students is: If we all stay resilient and united in the face of all challenges and threats, we shall emerge stronger as a nation!


