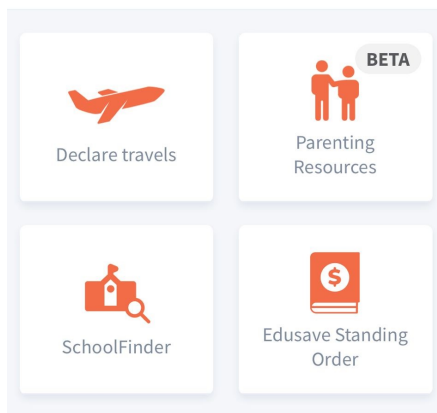

### Travel Declaration for March Holidays

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### Student COVID-19 Vaccination

We would like to encourage all parents/guardians who have yet to sign up for your child's/ward's vaccination, to do so sooner rather than later to protect your child/ward and your family. You could leverage the March holidays to accompany your child/ward to any of the 13 Paediatric Vaccination Centres (VC). Appointments can be made through the National Appointment System, or you can bring your child/ward under the general walk-in arrangement to any Paediatric VC from Monday to Thursday before 7pm, or Tuesday to Thursday before 5pm at Yusof Ishak Secondary School.

## Termly Learning Journeys

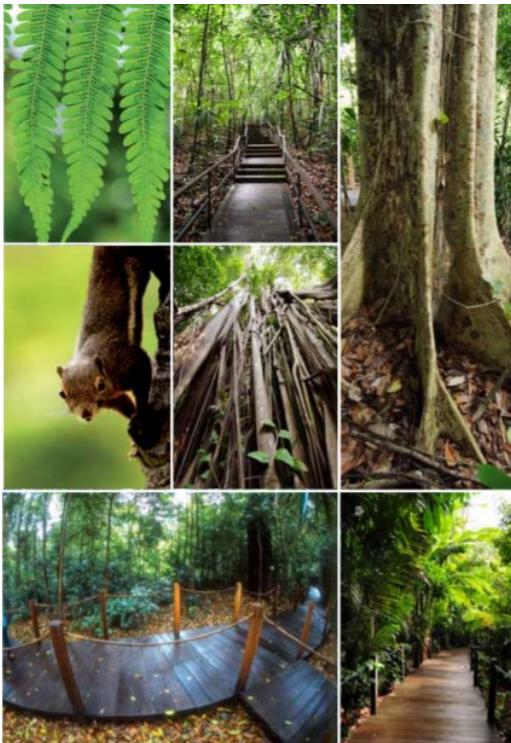
As part of the school's endeavours in our EXCITE Learning Approach where learning is designed to be experiential, authentic and purposeful, the school conducts termly learning journeys for all levels on the last Wednesday of each term. This term, our Kranjians will go on their virtual learning journeys on Wed 9 March 2022.

### P1, P2 & P5 Virtual Learning Journey to National Gallery

The students from P1, 2 and 5 will be going on a Virtual Learning Journey to the National Gallery. Gallery Children's Biennale has been a key programme of National Gallery Singapore since 2017, embodying the Gallery's commitment to inspiring young, curious minds with art. Every artwork in the Biennale is a space for self-expression and creative exploration, empowering children with a renewed sense of empathy and confidence to engage with the ever-changing world around them while embracing the shared values of acceptance, openness and diversity. We will be bringing our students on a Virtual Tour to some of the installations, to benefit those who do not have a chance to be there physically and to encourage those who can, to make a trip down. The learning journey will finish with an art activity in class.



### P3 & P6 Virtual Science Learning Journeys



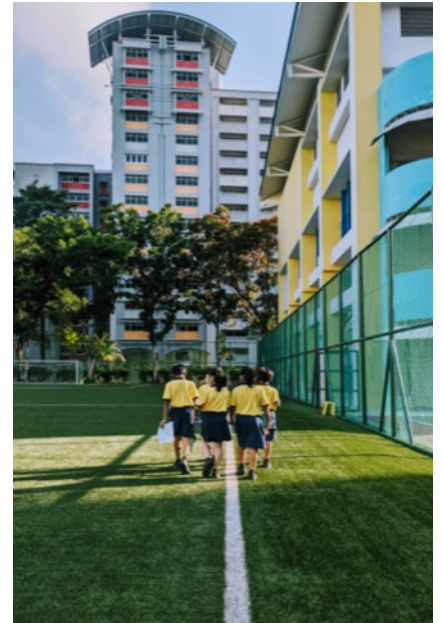
P3 and P6 students will embark on Science virtual learning journeys. These learning journeys aim to provide our students with authentic learning experiences beyond the classrooms. We also aim to make students more aware of their role in protecting the natural environment.

P3 students will virtually explore the rainforest trail of the Singapore Botanic Gardens, with interactive questions to reinforce their learning on the diversity of living things. Meanwhile, P6 students will be introduced to the concepts of adaptations and environmental conservation through their online exploration of the Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve. Facilitators will bring artefacts that will stimulate their senses and allow them to have a better experiential learning. Each student will receive a booklet that will have fun questions and activities to consolidate learning and supplement engagement.



## P4 Sports & Outdoor Experience Camp

The P4 Sports and Outdoor Experience Camp will be held at Kranji Primary School for all Primary 4 students from 7.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. on 9 March 2022. Students will take part in team building, in-school orienteering and sports experience through Tag Rugby. Through the camp, we hope to nurture their sporting interests in pursuing sports for life and to work cooperatively to solve group challenges. All safe management measures will be in place for the activities, with recess and snack break as usual. Normal lessons will resume from 12.30 pm to 1.30 pm.
