Applied Learning Programme Making a Paper Wallet

Materials needed:

1. Large paper bag
2. Scissors

Instructions on how to make a paper wallet:

Step 1: Cut out a 22cm by 28 cm rectangle (the side that you want to be on the outside is facing down).

Step 2: Fold the paper into eight equal parts.

Step 3: Cut 2.5cm slits into the lengthwise creases.

Step 4: Fold the left edge towards the last vertical crease. Then, fold the paper in half width wise.

Step 5: Cut off the bottom-left corner (Make sure your paper is properly oriented first).

Step 6: Fold down every other flap.

Step 7: Fold the paper into halves.

Step 8: With the diamond-shaped hole facing up, tuck the flaps into the wallet.

Your new paper wallet is complete! Enjoy using it!

Junior Tinkering Programme Making My Dream Playground

Materials needed:

1. Coloured construction paper
2. Markers or colour pencils
3. Scissors
4. Glue

Instructions on how to make a dream playground:

Step 1: Use a black marker to draw the trees, shrubs, swings, slides and rides found in a playground on a piece of paper.

Step 2: Colour the trees, shrubs, swings, slides and rides and cut out with a pair of scissors.

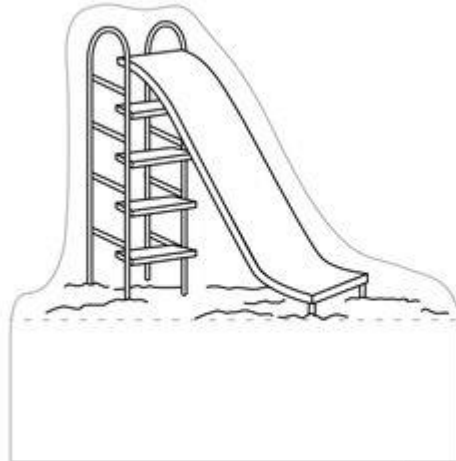
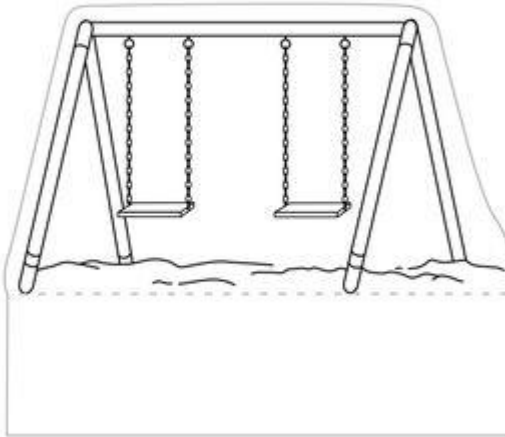
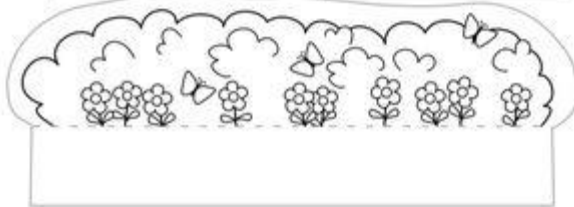
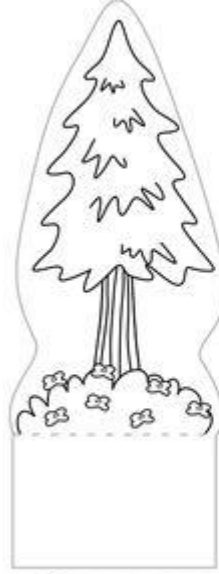
Step 3: Make the seesaw.

- You will need two pieces of paper. The first piece of paper is 8 cm x 16 cm. The second piece of paper is 4 cm x 16 cm.
- Fold the first piece of paper into half and glue it at the sides.
- Fold both ends of the paper. Cut the corners so that the ends are curved.
- Use a small strip of paper to make the handles of the seesaw and paste it with glue.
- Apply glue on the sides of the second piece of paper and roll it up.
- Apply some glue and fix both pieces together.

Step 4: Arrange the items and apply some glue to fix them in position.

Reading Programme
How to Make a Paper Chef's Hat

Materials needed:

1. 2 A4 papers
2. Crepe paper / tracing paper
3. Tape
4. Stapler

Instructions on how to make a paper chef's hat:

Step 1: Get a piece of crepe paper and fold the paper accordion style.

Step 2: Get two pieces of A4 papers. Tape two sheets of papers together. Fold in half and then in half again.

Step 3: Insert folded crepe paper into fold.

Step 4: Staple folded crepe paper to headband.

Step 5: Staple the ends and then along the headband.

Step 6: Gather top of crepe paper, twist and tape together.

Step 7: Flip hat inside out and tuck tip in.

Step 8: Staple band together.

Step 9: Staple opening of hat shut, keeping the tip tucked in.

Step 10: Fluff hat out gently.

Reading Programme
How to Make Pizza Bread

Materials needed:

1. Bread
2. Pizza sauce
3. Sausages
4. Grated cheese

Instructions on how to make pizza hat:

Step 1: Get a slice of bread and place it on your paper plate.

Step 2: Use a spoon and scoop some pizza sauce. Then, spread it on your bread.

Step 3: Scoop some cut sausages and arrange them on your bread.

Step 4: Get some cheese and lay them on your bread.

Step 5: Put it in the toaster and bake it for a few minutes.
