Dear Parents of P2 to P6 students,

Information on School Reopening 2022

1. A very warm welcome back to Kranji Primary School!
2. With 2021 coming to an end, my colleagues and I have been busy putting the finishing touches on our plans to welcome our students back to school next week. In preparation for the start of school, we would like to inform you of the following to ensure a smooth start to the new year:
 - a. Arrangements for first day of school (5 January 2022)
As announced by the Ministry of Education (MOE) on Tuesday, 21 December 2021, P2 to P6 students will **report to school on Wednesday, 5 January 2022**. School hours for 2022 remain unchanged for Mondays to Fridays from 7.30 am to 1.30 pm.
 - b. Students requiring care arrangements on 4 January 2022
 - i. For students who require care arrangement on the morning of Tuesday, 4 January 2022, parents are requested to submit your requests through the following link <https://go.gov.sg/kps-request-form-4jan22> or QR code by 5pm on **Thursday, 30 December 2021**. The school will follow up with more details once we receive your submission.
 - ii. School hours for P2 to P6 students reporting to school on Tuesday, 4 January will be from 7.30 am to 12.30 pm. If you require school bus services that day, please liaise with the school bus service provider directly.
 - iii. Our school-based Student Care Centre (SCC) operated by NASCANS will be open in the afternoon on Tuesday, 4 January 2022. P2 to P6 students who are in school in the morning and are current enrolled students in the SCC, will proceed to the SCC at 12.30 pm. For P2 to P6 students enrolled in the SCC who wish to attend SCC in the afternoon of Tuesday, 4 January 2022, the reporting time is 1.30 pm. Please inform NASCANS directly if you would like to send your child to the SCC in the afternoon.
3. The school will ensure that Safe Management Measures (SMM) are in place to keep our students safe. This includes the following:
 - a. Students and staff who are unwell, on Stay Home Notice or have flu-like symptoms such as fever and cough, will be required to stay away from school and seek medical treatment as soon as possible. Students and Staff should also test ART negative each day if they are on Health Risk Warning (HRW) or Close Contact Tracing (CCT) before entering the school. Please inform your child's Form Teachers or the school's General Office if any of the above applies to your child.
 - b. Students should bring along their Oral Digital Thermometers (ODT) to school on a daily basis. Students who need to purchase a replacement ODT can do so at the school bookshop when school starts.



- c. High-touch surfaces are cleaned frequently in school and the premises disinfected daily.
- d. Students and staff are required to wear their masks at all times when they are in school.
- e. Students will practise frequent hand-washing throughout the school day and practise wipe-down of tables and shared equipment after use.
- f. Recess and dismissal timings will be staggered to reduce congestion, in line with the national posture on Covid-19. Please be assured that all effort is taken to ensure that students have enough time to consume their food during recess.

- 4. Students and Staff are required to bring TraceTogether (TT) Token/App to school. Parents should check to ensure that your child’s TraceTogether token is in working order. Replacement of tokens can be done at the Community Centres or selected malls. Parents should collect the TT tokens for your child from any Community Centre/Club if you have not already done so. Singaporeans and Permanent Residents who are collecting their tokens for the first time can also request for the TT token to be delivered via post. Details can be found at <https://token.gowhere.gov.sg>.
- 5. On Tuesday, 21 December 2021, the Ministry of Education (MOE) and Early Childhood Development Agency (ECDA) issued a joint press release ‘Protecting Our Children from COVID-19 with Vaccination for 5 to 11-Year-Olds’. Information on the vaccination exercise has been sent out via Parents Gateway (PG) on Tuesday, 21 December 2021 for parents who are onboard and via Whatsapp to parents who are not on PG. Parents of P1 to P3 students will progressively receive a unique link via SMS to book a vaccination appointment from the week of 3 January 2022. Parents are encouraged to book a vaccination appointment when you are invited, in order to keep your children, your family and the wider community safe.

a. Excuse from Physical Education (PE) lessons and physical activities

Students who have taken their Covid-19 vaccination will be excused from PE and physical activities for 2 weeks after both doses of vaccination. Hence, we would like to request that parents who have booked appointments for your child, to submit the 2 confirmed vaccination dates using the link <https://go.gov.sg/kpsvaccine> or QR code. This will enable your child’s teachers to look out for your child and support him/her should he/she feel unwell.



- 6. Most Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) and school activities will remain suspended. More information will be provided in the January Letter to Parents.
